

Stained Interior Finish Touch Up Field Applied Instructions



ABSTRACT: This instruction demonstrates how to repair small imperfections. For procedures on repairing larger areas, contact your local Marvin representative.

<u>Supplies Needed</u>	
Tack cloth	Hair dryer (optional)
Paper towels for cleanup	200-400 grit sand paper



WARNING

Follow all safety, hazard, cleanup, and disposal instructions from the manufacturer of any product used to fill holes, dents, and minor imperfections as well as touch up materials.

1. Obtain correct color matched stained interior finish touch up bottle. Shake bottle to ensure contents are mixed.
2. Sand the affected area lightly with 200-400 grit sandpaper to feather out edges of existing coating.
3. Clean area properly with a tack cloth.

4. Apply stained interior finish to the surface of the area with applicator. Multiple light coats may be necessary, color match touched up area with adjacent surfaces. See figure 1.

Tip

To accelerate drying, use a hair dryer on low setting.

5. After the stain is dry to the touch, shake bottle of clear interior finish to ensure contents are mixed. Apply a coat of clear interior finish to the touched up surface. See figure 2.
